It's March 2022 and Russian tanks are roaring across the vast, snow-dusted fields of Ukraine. Their destination: Voznesensk, a town with a small bridge that could change the course of the war. Award-winning journalist Dom Phillips was writing *How to Save the Amazon* - a book he conceived as part-travelogue, part call to arms - when he and his colleague, the indigenous expert Bruno Pereira, were murdered in a remote part of the Amazon.

Dom's urgent, important, and hopeful message has been taken up by a group of contributors committed to preserving his vision for the book: to show why we all have a stake in saving the Amazon, and how we must ask the people who live and work there what needs to be done.

Before his death, Dom Phillips lived in Brazil for 14 years, visiting and reporting on the Amazon. He saw first hand the devastation wreaked upon its unique ecosystems. He was a passionate campaigner for the survival of the Amazon and wanted to take us to the heart of this great wonder of our planet, showing the myriad of peoples it sustains and the many ways in which we can avert the collapse of this incredible ecosystem. He was working on this book, alongside the indigenous expert Bruno Pereira, when they were murdered on 5 June 2022.

How to Save the Amazon remains true to Dom's initial vision, and crucially shows how important it is to listen to the experience and knowledge of the indigenous peoples who inhabit the forest.


DOM PHILLIPS was a highly experienced British freelance journalist. He moved to Brazil in 2007 and wrote extensively for British and American newspapers such as the Guardian and Washington Post.

In June 2022, Dom Phillips and his friend and guide Bruno Pereira were murdered in a remote part of the Amazon while researching this book.

In 2023, *How to Save the Amazon* was awarded a Creative Non-fiction Grant by the Whiting Foundation. It is the first time the grant has been awarded to a multiple-author project in the team of editors and colleagues that are finishing Dom's work in his legacy.

Plastic waste is everywhere – it has been found inside human foetuses and is present at the deepest part of our planet, the Mariana Trench – and this ubiquity has fuelled anti-plastic sentiment in recent years. But the backlash against this once miracle material isn't new. In the late 1980s, companies including McDonald's, Procter & Gamble, Coca-Cola and Mobil faced a sudden onslaught of pressure to tackle the rubbish created by their products. Millions of Americans were gripped by the fear that landfills were filling up when Mobro, a barge from New York, made national news as it embarked on a months-long odyssey to find a port that would allow it to dock and dump its cargo of waste.

Following the subsequent fallout, consumer brands launched a fierce campaign to prevent the introduction of anti-plastic laws. McDonald's promised its food-stained clamshell containers would be turned into new trays and toys, Mobil said its rubbish bags would degrade and disappear and P&G rhapsodised about how used Pampers would be composted into soil. None of them kept their promises, but the plastic bans went away. Decades on, our planet is increasingly plagued by plastic and brands are rolling out those same 'solutions' to protect the billions of dollars they make using the material.

In a compelling exposé in the vein of *Salt, Sugar, Fat* and *Fast Food Nation, Wall Street Journal* reporter Saabira Chaudhuri explores how the biggest brands in the world first got hooked on single-use plastic and what needs to change for them to finally break their addiction.

SAABIRA CHAUDHURI covers consumer goods for the *Wall Street Journal* from London. She has reported for the Journal for over a decade from London and previously New York, and has also worked for *Forbes* magazine, FastCompany.com and business newspaper *Mint*. She grew up in Bangalore, graduated magna cum laude with a BA in sociology from Mount Holyoke College in Massachusetts and won the *Wall Street Journal's* Asia fellowship to get a Masters in business and economic reporting from New York University.

Matlock has been involved in all three subsequent *Sex Pistols* reunions tours, the last of which took place in 2007 before relations with singer John Lydon once again broke down. In 2023 Matlock released his sixth solo album *Consequences Coming* and has joined Blondie for their forthcoming album and tour.



Adolf Hitler was one of six children born to his mother, and one of eight born to his father from two of his three marriages. Alois Hitler, né Schicklgruber, was an official of the Austrian customs service, and the combination of an imperial uniform and a severe drinking habit seems to have ensured that Hitler's father was a drunken bully given to beating his children if they were not instantly obedient.

Alois had two children, Alois junior and Angela, by his second wife, and six by his third, Hitler's mother Clara, of whom four, all boys, died at birth or in infancy. Young Adolf was therefore left with a half-brother, Alois, and half-sister, Angela, and a full sister, Paula, who died in 1960. When Hitler killed himself in April 1945, all his siblings were still living and some had children of their own. So, what happened to them?

The answer is that no one was really certain until David Gardner published this book in 2001, having patiently and steadfastly tracked down Hitler's living relations to the USA, and made contact with some of them. Now revised and updated, this is a fascinating study of a little-known side of Hitler's history, as well as a riveting account of how the author traced and contacted the survivors of a bloodline that most of the world probably hoped had become extinct.

DAVID GARDNER is a best-selling author and journalist, who worked as an editor with Newsweek until 2021. He also worked for the Daily Mail as a crime writer and senior foreign correspondent. The plea of insanity in criminal cases can be traced back at least to the Babylonian Code of Hammurabi, which dates from 1755-1759 BC. It is a complicated defence, and its origins in modern law lie with what are called the 'M'Naghten Rules' of 1843, formulated by British judges as a jury instruction in cases where a plea of insanity had been entered. Daniel M'Naghten shot and killed one Edward Drummond, believing him to be the British Prime Minister, Sir Robert Peel, and was acquitted on the grounds of insanity, and the M'Naghten Rules still exert considerable influence over defences today.

Clearly a plea of insanity in murder cases is of critical importance when the death penalty is still applied, and even today it may still be the difference between a life sentence in a high-security prison, or an indeterminate one in a secure psychiatric hospital. Meanwhile, 27 of the USA's 50 states have retained or readopted the death penalty, and at least 54 other countries, including China, Russia, India, Iran and Saudi Arabia, also retain it.

Naturally, a criminal who was liable to swing for murder could, and sometimes did, make every attempt to appear insane, and this book examines some of these cases, as well as trials in which the accused was indeed judged to be insane. The failure rate is high; of seven American serial killers who deployed the defence in their trials, only two were successful, ending their days in secure psychiatric facilities; two were executed, and the other three either died or were killed while serving full-life sentences, or are still in gaol.
